Keynote Speakers



Prof. Guang Ji - President of Shanghai University of Traditional Chinese Medicine
Prof. Ji's research focuses on developing diagnosis and treatment models of integrated medicine. He has innovative insights into disease syndrome classification, syndrome prediction and early warning system, and disease-syndrome integrated efficacy evaluation.



Dr Merlin Willcox - Clinical Lecturer in General Practice, University of Southampton
Dr Wilcox's main research interests are primary health care, clinical trials of traditional herbal medicine and maternal and child health. He has been involved in several clinical trials for malaria and helped to set up a network of people involved in this field (RITAM).



Dr Xiao-Yang Hu - Senior Research Fellow at the University of Southampton and National Institute for Health and Care Research. Dr Hu has coordinated multiple research activities over the past ten years, with total funding of £1.3M in the past five years and 40+ SCI publications centring around integrating Chinese medicine in UK primary care settings.



Dr Qihe Xu - Director of King's Centre for Integrative Chinese Medicine and Senior Lecturer in Renal Medicine & Pharmacology, King's College London.
Dr Xu dedicates to European-Chinese collaboration in the modernisation of TCM and in the development and dissemination of good practices in TCM research.



Charles Buck - 40 Years Experience as a TCM Clinical Expert, Educator & Author
He was chairman of the British Acupuncture Council and the head of other Chinese medicine organisations in Europe. His book "Acupuncture and Chinese Medicine - The Roots of Modern Practice" is well recommended.



Prof. Lei Zhang - Executive Deputy Director of the Collaborative Innovation Centre of Shanghai University of Traditional Chinese Medicine Prof. Zhang focuses on building a new model of TCM health service with the support of Internet-big data technology, the objectification and digitisation of the four diagnostic techniques.



Prof. Zan-Yu Chen - President of FTCMP
A well-known clinical expert and educator of TCM in Europe. Prof. Chen believes the Chinese medicine system helps modern society overcome diseases and provides an excellent alternative to deal current challenges, such as environmental crises.



Prof. Yue-Lai Chen - President of Longhua Hospital Affiliated to Shanghai University of Traditional Chinese Medicine. Prof. Chen has long been engaged in clinical practice and evidence-based research on acupuncture treatment of genitourinary diseases, stresses urinary incontinence, overactive bladder and prostatitis.



Prof. Xue-Yong Shen - Director of Shanghai Acupuncture Meridian Research Centre
Prof. Shen uses the multidisciplinary model to propose and verify the hypothesis that "the resonant infrared radiation and matching absorption of acupuncture points on moxibustion is the mechanism of action of moxibustion efficacy".



Amanda Shayle - Vice President of the Acupuncture Society
She has more than 20 years of clinical experience in TCM, majoring in women's health, dermatology and comprehensive facial beauty therapy. She teaches her unique method of facial acupuncture and innovated an now patented, intradermal needle.

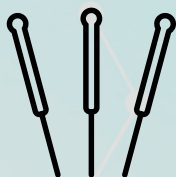
