Deadline

Final submissions to be made by **31st July 2024**.

Once we have checked over each submission, further time is allocated for any required changes. We aim to have the journal published for September/ October 2024, it may take up to 2 months in print.

Please note, whilst we hope to publish every submission sent to us, papers unfortunately will not be accepted if they do not have adequate content, fail to meet the requirements set or if submitted after the deadline set above to avoid any delays in publishing. Let us know if you need any advice regarding content and we will aim to help you the best we can.

What we are looking for

Personal Stories

We are looking for any stories of patients that you have or your own personal journey that you would like to share. This can be on any topic you feel is suited to you, from interesting findings or patients you have found fascinating, to your own story of how you got to where you are now within the industry it could even be about your studies if you are a student or perhaps talking about your clinic/ practice or somewhere interesting you have worked.

Word count

There is a minimum of **700** words, with **3500** words maximum.

Research Papers

We are asking for any research papers or case studies within Chinese Medicine that you would like to get out there. This cannot be something that has already been published, it must be new content. This can be submitted individually or as a collaborative piece.

Word count

There is a minimum of **3500** words, with no maximum.

Other Content Requirements

Name & qualifications

Your full name and any initials/ titles after your name.

Contact details

Any contact information you wish to be published. This could be an email address/ logo for example.

Profile description

Please write 30 to 50 words (on top of the word count) giving a little background on yourself.

Blurb

We require an introduction/ abstract about your submission, giving a short background description on the content of your piece. To be approximately 50 to 150 words (on top of the word count). This may vary by the length of your submission.

Profile picture

On top of your submission, we require a recent profile picture to go alongside your profile description.

This can be a group photo if it is a collaborative piece. Please ensure these are high quality and in the dimensions of: square 1000 x 1000 pixels or 1500 x 1000 pixels.

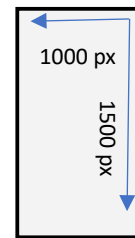
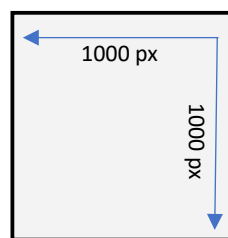
Images

We require related images to your submission that are compelling to look at, we want to make sure your submission looks as great as your written content. Please submit high print quality images in JPEG or PNG files.

Please note, we will not accept unowned replicated images, unless we have written consent from the original author, for example, company logos or images taken from the internet. We also ask that you get consent if you are submitting photos of your patients.

Personal stories:

We require a minimum of **3** supporting **high quality** images. Preferably square 1000 x 1000 pixels or 1500 x 1000 pixels.



Research Papers:

We require a minimum of **8** supporting **high quality** images. Preferably square 1000 x 1000 pixels or 1500 x 1000 pixels.

If there are supporting images that you do not have and would like us to source these for you, please discuss with CCMUK marketing team via email and we will be happy to help you. For example, lifestyle images such as acupuncture or images of Needles/ Chinese herbs/ flowers.

Graphs/ tables (optional)

You may wish to include graphs/ tables as a part of your submission, please make sure these are a high print quality.
